**Commissioner Jim Kordiak Named to Anoka County Committees**

Commissioner Jim Kordiak was named chair of the county's Parks and Community Services; Recycling and Resource Solutions; Property Records and Taxation; and Fairgrounds Advisory Committees at the Anoka County Board's January 3, 2017, organizational meeting. In addition, he will serve on the county's Management and Information Technology Committees; the Community Corrections Advisory Board; as the liaison for the Anoka County Historical Society; and as facilitator for the Waste Haulers Roundtable Group and Solid Waste Abatement Advisory Team. Kordiak was also appointed to the MetroGIS Policy Board and the Metropolitan Area Agency on Aging Board of Directors. He is the county's lead commissioner in the area of aging, real estate, and maps.

Kordiak will serve as an alternate on the Law Library Board of Trustees and the East Central Regional Juvenile Center Advisory Board. He was elected secretary of the Anoka County Regional Railroad Authority and will serve on the Anoka County Housing and Redevelopment Authority. He is a voting delegate for the District 10 Association of Minnesota Counties and first alternate for the National Association of Counties.

Kordiak represents District 4, which includes all of Columbia Heights and Hilltop, the majority of Fridley, and a portion of Spring Lake Park.
