RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR HIGH SPEED BROADBAND CONNECTIVITY

WHEREAS, Anoka County has embarked on a project to determine the interest in and needs for high speed broadband connectivity in Anoka County; and

WHEREAS, there are increasing educational, economic, and community benefits to increased high-speed connectivity.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RAMSEY, ANOKA COUNTY, STATE OF MINNESOTA, as follows:

- 1) That the City of Ramsey supports the effort of Anoka County to develop a broadband vision and solicit public/private partnerships through a Request for Proposal process.
- 2) That the City of Ramsey supports submission of a federal grant to secure funding to implement the broadband vision.
- 3) That the City of Ramsey recognizes that broadband through optical fiber will be a long-term benefit to all citizens.


