**Anoka County Does “I Do” Online!**

Couples applying for a marriage license in Anoka County can save time and simplify the process by filling out the application form online at [www.anokacounty.us/marriage](http://www.anokacounty.us/marriage). After filling out the online form, couples receive a confirmation number they'll need when they visit the Anoka County Vital Statistics Office to have their signatures witnessed and complete the marriage application process. Both the prospective bride and groom must appear in person at the Vital Statistics Office to sign the application, show identification, and pay the license fee. There are no blood tests or other requirements to marry in Minnesota; however, there is a waiting period of five business days. The Vital Statistics Office is located in Suite 120 of the Anoka County Government Center in Anoka.

Whether filling out the form online or using the paper form, couples will need to supply the following information:

- Full legal names
- Address and state of residence

## Anoka County Does “I Do” Online! – Add 1

- Date of birth
- Information about any previous marriages
- Full name of both the parties after marriage
- Social security numbers
- Information about any felony convictions on or after August 1, 2000
- Mailing address where the marriage certificate will be sent

If either party is a minor, an additional form is required. Call the Vital Statistics Office at 763-323-5201 for more information.

Processing of the online marriage application form is only available at the Anoka County Vital Statistics Office. Paper applications will still be accepted at the Vital Statistics Office as well as at all five Anoka County License Centers.
