Anoka County License Centers Would Remain Open During State Shutdown

All five Anoka County License Centers will remain open and able to complete most transactions in the event of a state government shutdown July 1. This includes driver's license renewals, title transfers, and license tab renewals.

If a state shutdown occurs, license centers will be unable to issue game and fish licenses; boat, snowmobile, or ATV licenses; or expedited motor vehicle titles.

Passports applications will continue to be accepted at the Blaine, Ham Lake, and Ramsey license center locations.

In addition, all vital statistics services normally offered in the Anoka County Office of Vital Statistics, Coon Rapids and Columbia Heights License Centers will be available including birth and death records, marriage applications, and marriage certificates.
