

BACKGROUND STUDY CHANGE

Background studies have always been required for anyone 13 years of age and older who live in the household or assist with children in care. In the past, Anoka County Child Care Licensing has waited for a provider's own child who will be turning 13 years old to complete their background study at relicensing or program review time. The MN Department of Human Services has recently clarified that those background studies should be conducted as soon as the individual turns 13 years of age. Licensed providers may either download an initial background study form off our website, or call the Child Care Licensing office at 763-323-6102, to have a background study form mailed out. Please remember that there is no additional fee for these background studies to be done, and if you have questions, to contact your licensor.
