SUPERvision in Your Child Care Home

Supervision issues continue to be one of the most common alleged complaint violations. Failure to properly supervise children is also the basis of the majority of negative actions taken against licensed providers. In an effort to help clarify the rules and expectations regarding supervision in licensed family child care homes, we will be discussing and reviewing:

- What is meant by “*supervision*” according to the rules
- What factors to consider in order to provide adequate supervision in a variety of settings
- Proactive measures to prevent problems

Supervision comes into play in every aspect of child care. Our goal is to reduce the number of incidents that result from inadequate or improper supervision, and to reinforce the effective practices being implemented. *This training is specifically geared to family child care.
