Sam Fettig Talk on Group Quarters and people experiencing homelessness

Group Quarters – any living arrangement where don't have an address and group setting... dorm, shelter, prison, etc. reach out in advance

GC – methods of data collection up to facility. E-Response, In person interview, dropoff/pickup of questionnaire, paper response data collection, facility self-enumeration (less common where site staff sworn in)

March 31st to April 1st Targeted non-sheltered outdoor locations – CB (Census Bureau) staff goes out for 24 to count Enumeration of transitory locations (county of transitory populations): similar to others; ex: circus, campground,

How can partners assist? Raise awareness with clients. Resources (volunteers, computers, etc.). Need to have taken oath when going out to do the count; but can go out and advocate prior to or after. \$22/hr to work with CB; so advocate for clients to apply.

5. Safe Families – Elizabeth Beseke – 15 minutes

Safe families helps wrap around families to make them feel safe and comfortable with 'circle of support'. Come around at time of need (usually time of isolation). Consists of:

1. Safe home (host home and backup)
2. Resource friend (meals, cloths, etc. for families or host families)
3. Family friend
4. Family coach (facilitates relationships and help setting goals with parents) Surviving goals and thriving goals.

Volunteers needed to help out in circle or with intake etc. Give them a call.

Primarily through churches for volunteers, but not exclusively

Referral families – families without extended families; homeless and cannot find housing with kids, mental health/chemical dependency treatment,

Intake line – 651-762-2777; not on call right now (emergencies) but hopefully in a few months.
