### **Andover Fatal Motor Vehicle Crash**

On September 13, 2019 at 7:41 a.m., the Anoka County Sheriff's Office, Andover Fire-Rescue, and Allina Ambulance responded to a report of a personal injury motor vehicle crash on 165<sup>th</sup> Ave. (CR 7) at Makah St. NW in the City of Andover. One of the two vehicles involved was on fire. Bystanders were able to remove that driver from that vehicle. Lifesaving efforts were attempted, but both drivers were pronounced dead at the scene. There were no passengers in either vehicle.

Initial information shows that one vehicle was traveling eastbound on 165<sup>th</sup> Ave. NW and the other vehicle was traveling westbound when they collided head on. The crash remains under investigation by the Minnesota State Patrol, the Midwest Medical Examiner's Office, and the Anoka County Sheriff's Office. No additional information will be released at this time.
