### Spring Lake Park Shooting – Decedent and Victim Identification

This is an update to the original press release sent on December 22, 2019 regarding the shooting in the City of Spring Lake Park.

The decedent in this incident has been identified as:

**Chai Yang, age 19, of St. Paul, MN**

Another victim, with minor injuries, has been identified, bringing the total number of injured victims to seven (7). None of the surviving victims has injuries that are considered life threatening. The surviving victims are identified as:

**Ger Yang, age 29, of Pine City, MN**

**Keng Moua, age 19, of St. Paul, MN**

**Chimua Lor, age 22 of St. Paul, MN**

**Lee Vang Lor, age 38 of St. Paul, MN**

**Jann Her, age 34, of St. Paul, MN**

**John Thoa, age 26, of St. Paul, MN**

**Kou Yang, age 37, of St. Paul, MN**

There are no suspects in custody at this time. Detectives believe that there are bystanders who have video recordings of this incident.
