Coon Rapids License Center Closing Tuesday, March 17

The Coon Rapids License Center, 455 99th Ave. NW, is closing tomorrow due to construction-related activities. There is not currently a specified date as to when the license center will reopen.

The center is down to four stations, and completely closing to the public will allow construction to be finished sooner. This closing does not affect the Coon Rapids Passport Center.

Staff at the Coon Rapids License Center will be redeployed to the county's other license centers – Blaine, Ham Lake, Ramsey and Columbia Heights – while construction commences.

Residents who have their tab renewal notices can still do so at the Coon Rapids location via a tab renewal drop-off box. Instructions are located on the box.
