Blaine Fatal Motor Vehicle Crash Involving a Bicyclist

On March 20, 2020 at 6:36 p.m., Blaine Police Department, SBM Fire, Allina EMS and Anoka County Sheriff's Office responded to a report of a personal injury motor vehicle crash at the intersection of 129th Ave. NE and Lincoln St. in the City of Blaine. Upon arrival, first responders attempted lifesaving measures on a teenage male victim, however he was later pronounced deceased on-scene. The Minnesota State Patrol is assisting with crash reconstruction.

Early information shows the teenage male victim was riding a bicycle along with two other teenagers that were with him. They were traveling eastbound on 129th Ave. when a westbound Saab passenger car driven by an adult male struck the victim head-on. The identities of those involved are being withheld at this time. It is unknown if alcohol was a contributing factor in this crash.

The crash remains under investigation by the Blaine Police Department, Minnesota State Patrol, Midwest Medical Examiner's Office, and the Anoka County Sheriff's Office. No additional information will be released at this time.
