2020 Minnesota Sheriffs' Association Scholarship Program

Sheriff James Stuart of Anoka County announced today the commencement of the Law Enforcement Scholarship Program for 2020. The Minnesota Sheriffs' Association Board of Directors has established the scholarship fund which awards up to 15- \$600 scholarships for this year. These scholarships are due to the coordinated efforts of the 87 Sheriffs of the State of Minnesota.

The Minnesota Sheriffs' Association recognizes the value in assisting students meet some of their financial obligations while attending law enforcement training. "The next generation of protectors needs our collective support and encouragement. We are excited to see this program continue as we seek to recruit and hire the best possible candidates to serve our communities." said Sheriff Stuart.

Scholarships are only available to students currently enrolled in one of the following three categories:

1. Mandated POST Skills Program
2. In their second year of a two-year law enforcement program.
3. In their third or fourth year of a four-year college criminal justice program.

The Scholarship Committee, in making its selection of awards, intends on achieving representation from all geographical areas of the state. Scholarship awards will be announced by December 28th of the same year.
