Fridley Missing Person Update

On March 30, 2021, the Fridley Police Department issued a press release regarding the report of a missing 10-year-old female, Ava Whitfield, who may be driving a black 2018 Chevrolet Equinox with the Minnesota license plate BAU-358.

The last known location for Ava was in the area of France Ave. S and Interstate 494 at approximately 8:00 P.M. yesterday. Ava is suspected as being in the Eden Prairie, Bloomington, and Edina areas yesterday and has been wearing the same clothing when seen at multiple locations. Recent photos from yesterday are attached to this release.
