Walk-in Service Available Again at Anoka County License Centers

To meet the needs of Anoka County License Center customers, all Anoka County License Center locations will again be allowing walk-in traffic during normal business hours, in addition to offering pre-scheduled appointments.

In response to public health guidelines related to the COVID-19 pandemic, Anoka County License and Passport Centers had implemented an appointment-only model. This option is still in place, and customers can choose to make appointments to ensure their business is conducted in a timely manner. Drop boxes, located outside seven buildings in cities around the county, can also still be used to deliver documentation for processing.
