Ramsey Construction Death

On September 8, 2021, at approximately 8:31 P.M., the Ramsey Police Department, Ramsey Fire Department, and Allina EMS responded to a report of an unconscious male who was involved in a road construction accident near Armstrong Blvd NW and Bunker Lake Blvd NW in the city of Ramsey. Lifesaving measures were attempted by responders, but unfortunately the male was declared deceased at the scene.

Early indications show that a construction semi-truck traveling westbound on Bunker Lake Blvd NW, reversed eastbound to attach to a mill when the decedent was caught in the rear wheel of the semi and run over. The decedent was employed by the private contractor hired to repave the portion of Bunker Lake Blvd NW.

The incident is under investigation by the Ramsey Police Department, Minnesota State Patrol, Midwest Medical Examiner's Office, and Anoka County Sheriff's Office. No additional information will be provided at this time.
