Andover Fatal Crash

On September 25, 2021, at approximately 10:02 A.M., the Anoka County Sheriff's Office, Anoka Police Department, Ramsey Police Department, Andover Fire Department, and Allina EMS responded to a crash that occurred between a passenger vehicle and pickup truck near the 16400 block of County Road 7 in the city of Andover.

Early indications show that the passenger vehicle was traveling northbound, and the pickup truck was traveling southbound on County Road 7 when a collision between the vehicles occurred. The driver of the passenger vehicle was declared deceased at the scene, while two passengers were critically injured. One passenger was airlifted via LifeLink III to a nearby hospital and the other was transported to a nearby hospital via ambulance. The two occupants in the pickup truck were also transported via ambulance to a local hospital.

The incident is under investigation by the Minnesota State Patrol, Midwest Medical Examiner's Office, and Anoka County Sheriff's Office. No additional information will be provided at this time.
