## **Fridley Fatal Semi-Truck vs Pedestrian Crash**

On November 23, 2021, at approximately 5:28 P.M., the Fridley Police Department, Fridley Fire Department, and Allina EMS responded to a report of a crash involving a semi-truck and pedestrian on old Central Ave NE near 72<sup>nd</sup> Ave NE in the city of Fridley.

Early indications show that an adult male driving a semi-truck was traveling northbound on old Central Ave NE and attempting to turn westbound onto 72<sup>nd</sup> Ave NE, when an adult male attempting to cross was hit by the truck. Emergency responders administered life saving measures to the pedestrian, and he was transported via ambulance to Hennepin Healthcare where he was declared deceased. The semi-truck driver was not injured.

This incident is under investigation by the Fridley Police Department, Minnesota State Patrol, Hennepin County Medical Examiner's Office, and Anoka County Sheriff's Office. No additional information will be provided at this time.
