## **Columbia Heights Motor Vehicle vs Pedestrian Crash**

On April 9, 2022, at approximately 9:08 P.M., the Columbia Heights Police Department, Columbia Heights Fire Department, and Allina EMS responded to a report of a pedestrian hit by a motor vehicle near Central Ave NE and 45<sup>th</sup> Ave NE in the City of Columbia Heights.

Early indications show that an adult male was attempting to cross on foot outside of a crosswalk going westbound on Central Ave NE. While crossing, he was hit by a SUV driven by an adult female traveling southbound on Central Ave NE. The male was transported via ambulance to a local hospital where he is currently in critical condition.

This incident is under investigation by the Columbia Heights Police Department, Minnesota State Patrol, and Anoka County Sheriff's Office. No additional information will be provided at this time.
