Ramsey Fatal Motor Vehicle Crash

On May 17th, 2022, at approximately 7:52 PM, the Ramsey Police Department, Ramsey Fire Department, Anoka County Sheriff's Office, and Allina Paramedics responded to the intersection of Bunker Lake Blvd. NW at Sunfish Lake Blvd. NW in the City of Ramsey on a report of a motor vehicle crash with injuries.

Early indications show that a 2011 Toyota Camry was westbound on Bunker Lake Blvd. NW when it collided with a 2019 Jeep Grand Cherokee that was southbound on Sunfish Lake Blvd. NW. The adult male driver of the Camry was transported to a nearby hospital and is in critical condition. The adult female driver of the Grand Cherokee was transported to a nearby hospital with non-life-threatening injuries. A passenger in the Grand Cherokee, also an adult female, was transported to a nearby hospital where she was pronounced deceased. The Minnesota State Patrol is on scene assisting investigators with reconstruction of the crash.

This incident is under investigation by the Ramsey Police Department, Anoka County Sheriff's Office, Minnesota State Patrol, and the Midwest Medical Examiner's Office. The investigation is in its early stages and additional information will not be released at this time. The name of the decedent is being withheld pending notification of next of kin.
