WHAT ARE OPIOIDS?

Morphine, Codeine, Methadone, Oxycodone (OxyContin[®], Percodan[®], Percocet[®]), Hydrocodone (Vicodin[®], Lortab[®], Norco[®]), fentanyl (Duragesic[®], Fentora[®]), Hydromorphone (Dilaudid[®], Exalgo[®]), and Buprenorphine (Subutex[®], Suboxone[®]).

Opioids may lead to addiction and an overdose may occur if abused.
