**SESSION DATES:** The ACT Class is typically held on the first Monday of each month.

**PROGRAM COST:** The \$45 fee must be paid before your child is enrolled.

**Payment must be received 30 days from the date of when you receive this notice.**

Upon receipt of payment, the juvenile will be scheduled into the next available session. You will be notified of his/her date. **Participation in the program must be completed within 90 days of the court date.**
