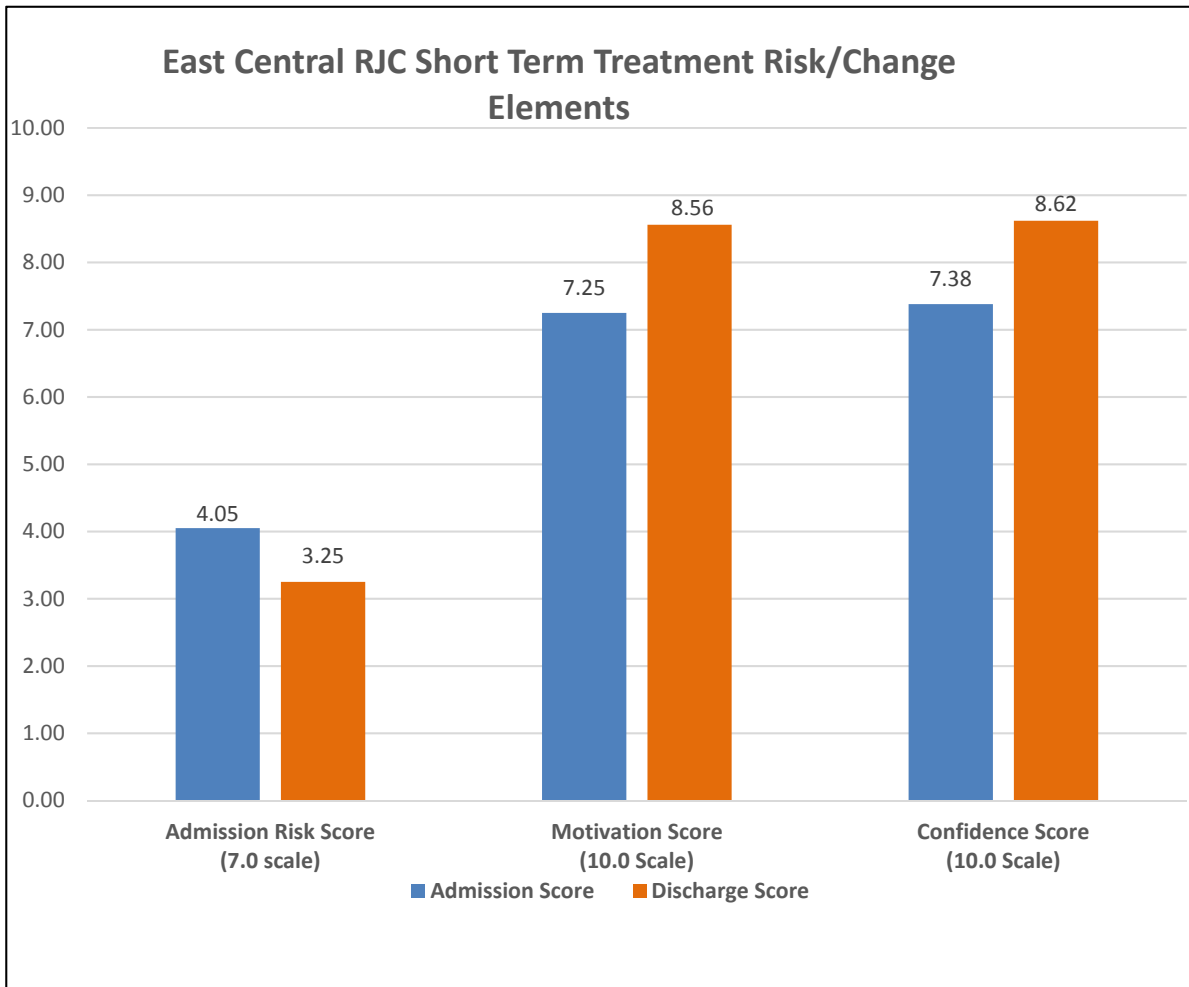

RESIDENT/FAMILY SURVEYS: 110 Parent, 163 Resident, and 10 Agent Surveys completed.

110 Parent Surveys: 96% of the parents surveyed felt their child received basic needs, including food, shelter, recreation, and schooling. Over 90% of the parents felt their child was placed in a safe environment. 77% of the parents felt that their child's behavior improved while in the program and had a positive impact on the youth's ability to be successful.

163 Resident Surveys: 92% of residents surveyed felt their physical and emotional needs were being met. 88% of the residents that completed surveys were 15-18 years of age. 93% felt safe while in placement and 86% felt that living at RJC had a positive impact on their ability to succeed.

10 Agent Surveys: 100% of the agents who completed the survey believe their clients are placed in a safe environment. 86% of the agents felt their clients received appropriate medical, dental, and mental health care.
