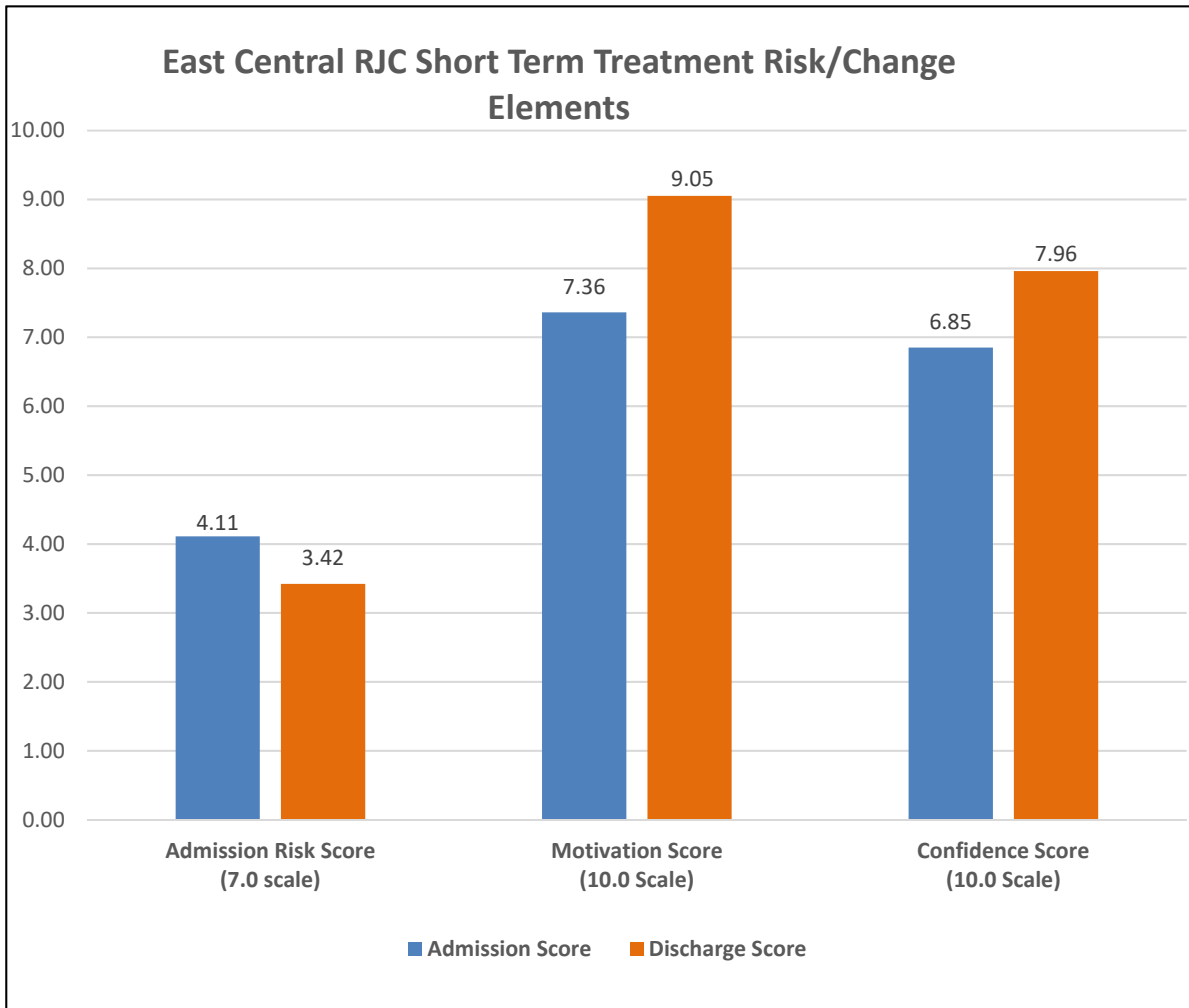

RESIDENT/FAMILY SURVEYS: 90 Parent, 120 Resident, and 9 Agent Surveys completed.

90 Parent Surveys: 90 parent surveys were completed with 43% of the results received from parents' of 30/15 program youth. During their child's stay, 74% of the parents surveyed believe their child's educational needs were met. 72% of the parents felt their child's behavior improved while in the program, and 90% of the parents felt their child was placed in a safe environment.

120 Resident Surveys: 87% of the youth surveyed were 15 years and older with 80% being male. 97% of the youth felt they received proper orientation into the program, along with 94% stating their basic needs of food, clothing, hygiene, and recreation were met. 97% of the youth felt their primary counselor met with them to address goals and 83% felt that living at RJC had a positive effect on their ability to succeed.

9 Agent Surveys: All agents surveyed strongly agree that their client's basic needs were being met. 100% of the agents surveyed agree that their clients are in a safe environment where staff are both helpful and informative.
