📍 RUM RIVER NORTH COUNTY PARK

The 80-acre Rum River North County Park is the northern access to the Rum River Canoe Corridor. The Rum River begins at Mille Lacs Lake and flows 153 miles to the Mississippi River in Anoka.

🚣 AVERAGE CANOE/KAYAK TRIP

from Rum River North County Park to Rum River Central Regional Park is 2.5 - 3 hours, and from Rum River Central Regional Park to Rum River South County Park is 3 - 3.5 hours.
