

## NATURAL RESOURCES AND WILDLIFE


**BROWN THRASHER** This large reddish-brown bird is in the same family as Mockingbirds. It prefers dense, shrubby habitat in which to hide and forage. They have immense vocal abilities, with perhaps over 1,000 songs.

**MINK** A medium-sized, semiaquatic weasel that is often found hunting along waterways. They are carnivores like other weasels and will eat fish and other aquatic life, small mammals, birds, and eggs.

**BROWN CREEPER** This diminutive and secretive bird can be found circling its way upward on tree trunks. It has a small curved bill to help it probe the bark for small insects and spiders. It is the only member of its family, the treecreepers (Certhiidae), found in North America.
