



Hazardous Waste Generator Licensing Schedule

This licensing schedule applies to VSQGs, SQGs, LQGS, and Class I and II Used Oil Generators. To be eligible for an Anoka County hazardous waste generator license that is effective April 1 of each year, you must:

1. Submit the Hazardous Waste Annual Report and License Application
2. Pay your license fee

Important Licensing Dates

The license period runs from April 1 of the license year through March 31 of the following year. The following is the licensing process and important dates for each year:

Mid December

The Hazardous Waste Annual Report and License Applications are printed and mailed from Anoka County to licensed generators.

January 31

Hazardous Waste Annual Report and License Applications are due.

*Once license applications are completed and returned to Anoka County, an invoice is created that includes the license fee and any applicable late fees. A paper copy of the invoice will be mailed to the mailing contact of the generator.

January through March

Invoices issued before March 1 must be paid within 30 days. Subsequent invoices, such as 1st past due or 2nd past due invoices are due upon receipt.

March 31

Invoices issued March 1 or after must be paid by March 31. If the invoice is not paid by March 31, generators are immediately considered to be operating without a license.

***Hazardous Waste Generator Licenses will be printed and mailed to the mailing contact of the generator when the invoice is paid in full.**
