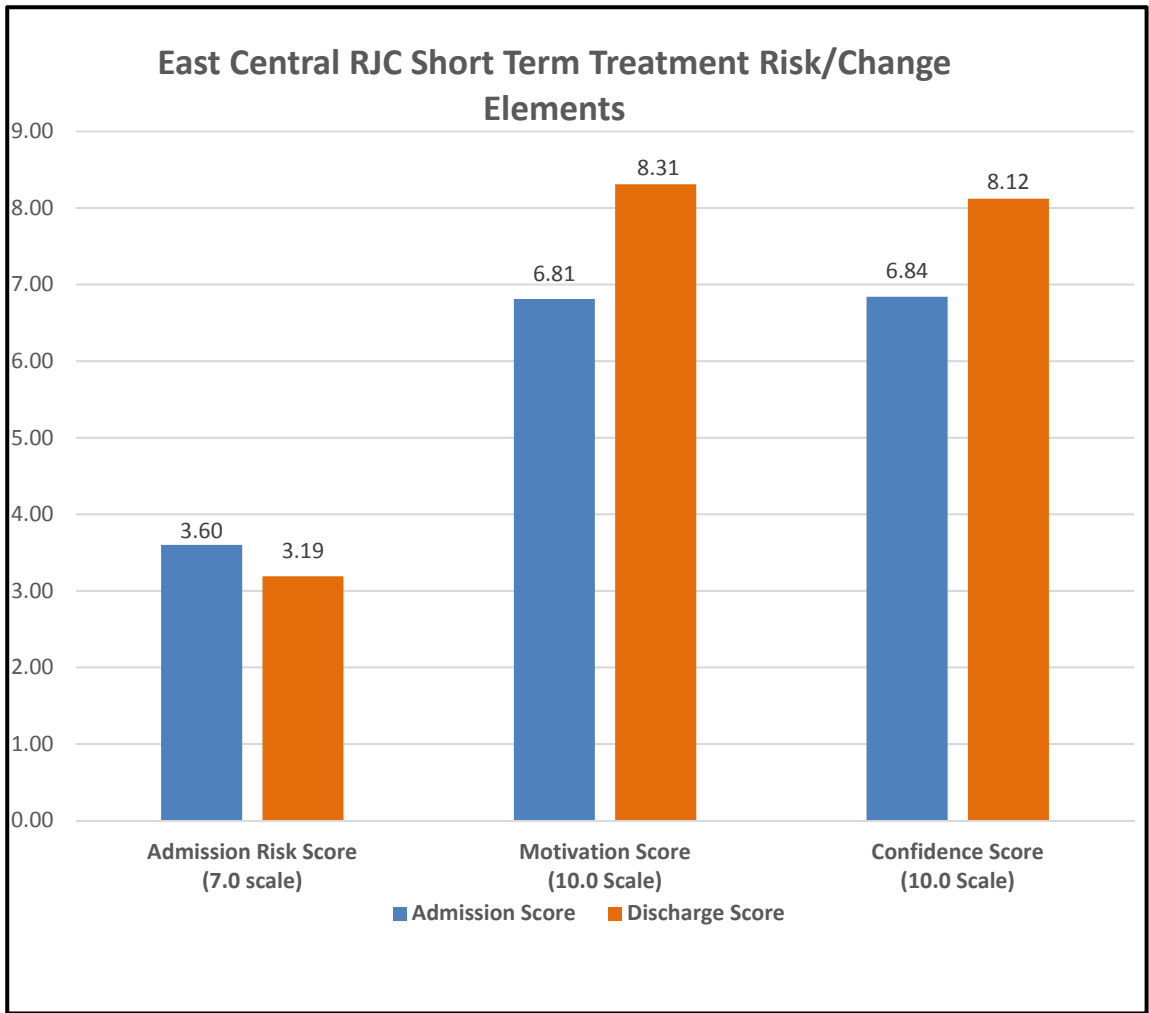

RESIDENT/FAMILY SURVEYS: 101 Parent, 155 Resident, and 11 Agent Surveys completed.

101 Parent Surveys: 93% believed RJC provided their child's basic needs, including food, shelter, recreation, and school. 94% stated that RJC staff were courteous and professional when parents visited or called RJC.

155 Resident Surveys: 84% agreed that RJC met their basic needs including medical, food, clothing, hygiene and recreation. 86% agreed that they received realistic consequences for their anti-social choices, while 80% believed they received positive reinforcement or encouragement for pro social behaviors.

11 Agent Surveys: Referring agents continue to support the services and direction that RJC offers to their clients. All the agents surveyed agree their client's educational, medical and mental health needs are being met.
