2016 Accomplishments:

- A staff retirement, combined with county wide lateral movement opportunities resulted in the hiring of three new RJC Probation Officers: Carter Ellena, Tom Peick, and Nick Wagner
- Implementation of Crisis Intervention Training, along with an introduction in Trauma Informed Care.
- Implementation of a new resident survey measuring Professional Alliance traits exhibited by RJC staff.
- East Central Regional Juvenile Center averaged a daily population of 29.5 youth.
- Ongoing implementation of evidence based practices, weekly programming, and staff trainings.

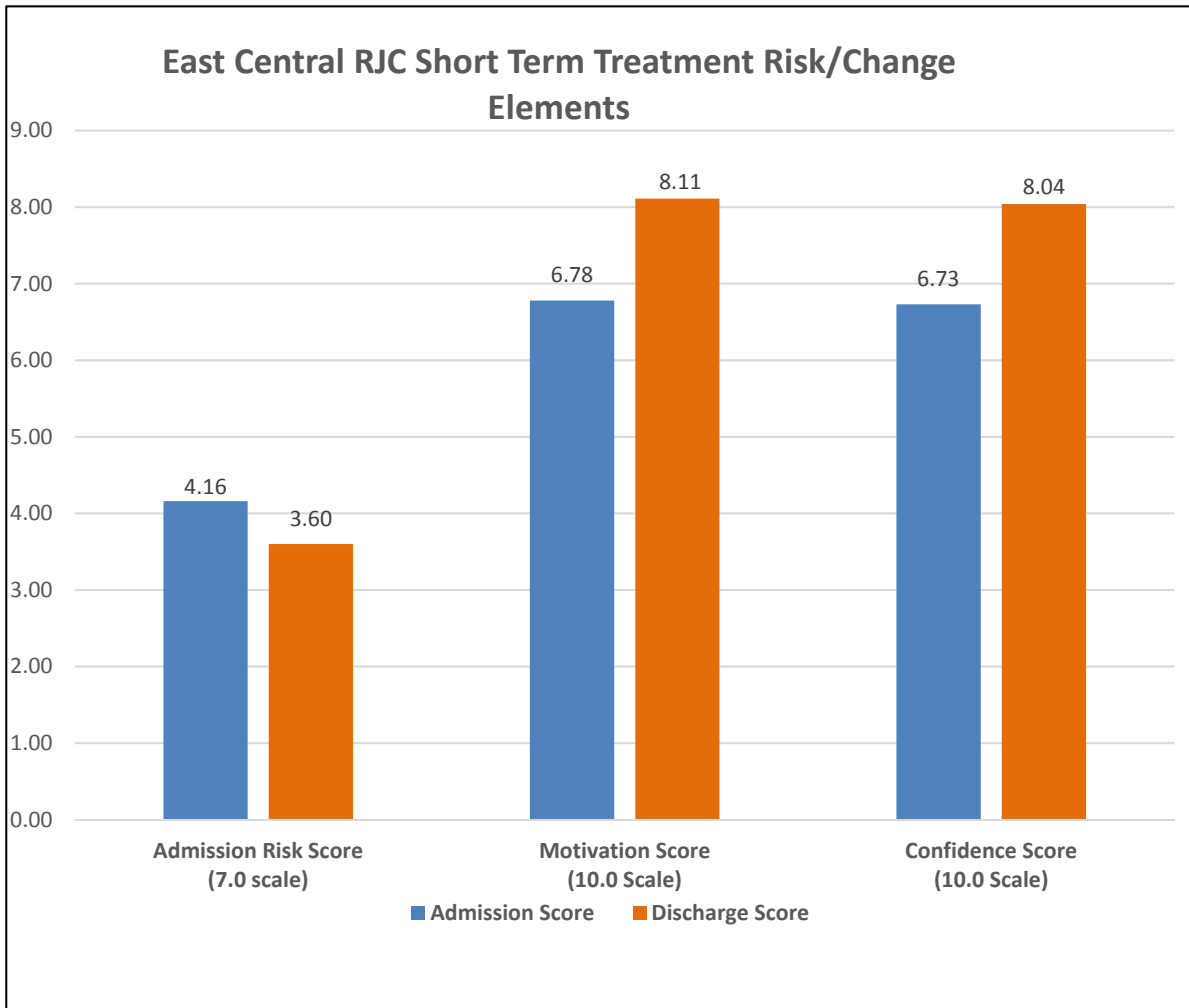

RESIDENT/FAMILY SURVEYS: 112 Parent, 151 Resident, and 15 Agent Surveys completed.

112 Parent Surveys: 92% of the parents surveyed believe their child's basic needs of food, shelter, recreation, and schooling were being provided for. 90% stated they felt that RJC was providing a safe environment for their children, while 32% were undecided whether their child's behavior improved while in the program.

151 Resident Surveys: 88% of the residents surveyed were 15 years and older. 88% of the residents felt safe at RJC and 81% felt that RJC had a positive effect on their ability to succeed.

15 Agent Surveys: 100% of the agents surveyed were contacted when their client arrived at RJC. That same percentage felt their client's basic needs were met. 94% of the agents felt their clients stay had a positive impact on them. Agents placing clients at RJC continue to be in strong support of the services their clients are receiving.
