ACTION REQUESTED	The IT Director is requesting the IT Committee recommend to the County Board to approve purchase orders issued annually with Insight Public Sector for the Microsoft Enterprise Agreement and Server Cloud Enrollment in an amount not to exceed \$2,609,634.76.
BACKGROUND	<p>In 2009, the County entered into an agreement with Microsoft to purchase an enterprise agreement for licensing the County's servers, file, print and email functionality. This also provided for the licensing needed for the County's PC Operating Systems and Microsoft Office licenses required for 2,600 workstations.</p> <p>Since 2009 the county has made a strategic investment of more than \$6.5M on our Microsoft solution.</p>
SOLUTIONS	As a result of the initial agreement and our continued use of this mission critical technology, the County is required to renew its agreement, in accordance with the state contract in April of 2021.
CONCLUSION	The County utilizes the State contract as the vehicle to renew its agreement for Microsoft products through Insight Public Sector our value-added reseller, utilizing the efficient processes of the State's already negotiated contract with Microsoft. By using the State's contract to continue our licensing platform, we can ensure the best pricing and continued functionality of this technology.
