10/5 Program

Youth ordered to complete the 10/5 program at the Anoka County Non-Secure Program will be committed to the program for 10 days but may complete in 5 days based on positive behavior and successful completion. Youth are programmed individually, complete assignments, community work service, and attend school daily.

Visiting


Sunday: 1:00-4:00 p.m.

- * Legal guardians must have a valid photo ID, siblings under 18 must be accompanied by legal guardian, all other visitors must be approved prior to visit.
- * Leave all belonging secured in your vehicle (cellphones, purses, etc).
- * No more then 3 visitors at one time.
- * Only unopened, factory sealed food/drink items will be allowed into the building. No glass.

Serving both males and females 10 to 18 years of age, the Anoka County Non-Secure Program (NSP) offers short and long term programming with three separate groups. The short term group consists of all female youth awaiting their next court appearance or completing court ordered short term programs. The long term group consists of all female youth court ordered to complete a long term program. The all male group consists of youth awaiting next court appearances, waiting for next placements, or completing court ordered short and long term programs.

Parent/Guardian Checklist:

- ✓ **Medical insurance card/information**
- ✓ **Clothing & hygiene (personal clothing and hygiene is permitted)**
- ✓ **Prescription medication (must be in original bottle/packaging with prescription label)**
- ✓ **Limited money will be accepted for youth, facility provides canteen money for youth weekly**
