70/90 New Choices Program (Chemical Dependency)

Youth ordered to complete the 70/90 New Choices for Adolescents Chemical Dependency Program at the East Central Regional Juvenile Center will be committed for a minimum of 70 days and a maximum of 90 days. Youth will be held accountable for their behaviors while completing outpatient chemical dependency treatment. As a part of a peer group, youth will attend school daily, complete all daily facility job responsibilities as well as living skills.

- * Legal guardians are able to visit along with sibling over the age of 18 with valid photo ID, all other visitors must be approved prior to visit.
- * Leave all belonging secured in your vehicle (cellphones, purses, etc).
- * Vending machines on-site, no food or drink items will be allowed into the building.

About Us

Serving both males and females 10 to 18 years of age, the East Central Regional Juvenile Center (RJC) offers short term programming with three separate groups. The all male detention group consists of youth awaiting court hearings and/or waiting to go to their next placement. The all female program group consists of youth awaiting court hearings, placement, or who have been adjudicated and are completing court ordered programs. The third all male program group consists of adjudicated youth completing court ordered programs.

Parent/Guardian Checklist:

- ✓ **Clothing & hygiene (personal clothing and hygiene is permitted)**
- ✓ **Prescription medication (must be in original bottle/packaging with prescription label)**
- ✓ **Limited money will be accepted for youth, facility provides canteen money for youth weekly**
