

FAMILY & GROUP FAMILY CHILD CARE AGE GROUP DEFINITIONS

INFANT means a child who is at **least six weeks of age**, but less than twelve months of age.

TODDLER means a child who is at least 12 months old, but less than 24 months old for family and group family child care (Class A and Class C1, C2, C3.) For specialized infant and toddler family and specialized group family child care (Class B1, B2, and D) a toddler means a child who is at least 12 months old but less than 30 months old.

CLASS

- A 12 months to less than 24 months
- B1 12 months to less than 30 months
- B2 12 months to less than 30 months
- C1 12 months to less than 24 months
- C2 12 months to less than 24 months
- C3 12 months to less than 24 months
- D 12 months to less than 30 months

PRESCHOOLER means a child who is at least 24 months old up to the age of 5.

SCHOOL AGE child means a child who is at least 5 years of age, but is younger than 11 years of age.
