


LOCKS

CABINETS & DRAWERS

Magnetic Locks, such as the following, and **Keyed locks** are effective for cabinets and drawers.



Standard Tot Locks such as those below are not as reliable to make hazardous items “inaccessible”.



DOORS

Bi-fold door covers, such as the one shown here, are effective. The bi-fold door cover slides over the hinged area to prevent doors from opening.



LOCKS Cont'd

DOORS

Brass plated door locks, such as the one shown here, **are effective**. Lift and flip it in one direction to open the door, slip back and the door stays locked. Installs easily and conveniently, 5 feet or higher on the doorframe. Needs 1/8" space between doorframe and door.



Chain locks and Hook & Eye locks such as the following **are effective**.



Doorknob covers such as the following are **not reliable**.
